MEMBERSHIP TYPES

FAMILY memberships are offered for married couples where both individuals are Jewish.

- F1.** Family with children in Religious School (Aleph - Hey classes)
- F2.** Family without children in Religious School - Either no children, children above Religious School age and/or children under Religious School (Aleph / 3rd grade) age.
- F3.** Senior Family - One member must be at least 65 years old with no children in Religious school.

INDIVIDUAL memberships are offered to single Jewish individuals and to married couples where only one individual is Jewish.

- I1.** Individual with children in Religious School (Aleph - Hey classes)
- I2.** Individual without children in Religious School — Either no children, children above Religious School age and/or children under Religious School (Aleph / 3rd grade) age.
- I3.** Senior Individual — The individual member is at least 65 years old with no children in Religious school
- I4.** JCC Kehillah / PBJC Member — Single individual JCC member 21-30 years old.

ASSOCIATE memberships are offered to Jewish families and Jewish individuals with children, when the oldest child is not old enough to participate in PBJC Religious School (Aleph & higher / normally 3rd grade & higher) classes.

JCC KEHILLA / PBJC MEMBERSHIP — PBJC membership offered to single Jewish individuals who are members of the JCC of West Orange & Whippany. Limited to individuals age 21-30.

Note— Membership dues (for all members) and Building Fund commitments (for new members) are subject to change as part of the annual PBJC budget process. Members are subject to participating in assessments as approved by the PBJC Board of Trustees.

Special Payment Terms — PBJC offers special payment terms to any member in need. Requests for special terms should be directed to the Executive Director. All requests will be kept strictly confidential.

MEMBER BENEFIT INFORMATION

Family & Individual Members in good standing are eligible to receive:

- A. Tickets to the High Holiday Services (as per the PBJC High Holiday ticket policy)
- B. Extended Family High Holiday Service tickets at a reduced rate.
- C. Member discounts for PBJC Nursery School and other programs, when offered.
- D. Early registration privileges for Nursery School, Summer Camp and PBJC early educational programs. Membership status as of October 1st determines whether you may register for the following school year.

JCC Kehillah Members in good standing are eligible to receive:

- A. A ticket to the High Holiday Services (as per the PBJC High Holiday ticket policy)

Associate Members in good standing are eligible to receive:

- A. Tickets to the High Holiday Family Service (only)
- B. Member discounts for PBJC Nursery School and other programs, when offered. The annual member discount will be limited to 50% of the value of the Associate membership annual dues per fiscal year, per family.
- C. Early registration privileges for Nursery School, Mom & Me, Summer Camp and PBJC early educational programs. Membership status as of October 1st determines whether you may register for the following school year.
- D. The fiscal membership year is January 1 - December 31.

PAYMENT & BILLING INFORMATION

Family and Individual Members:

- A. The fiscal membership year is January 1—December 31.
- B. Dues begin in the quarter that the member joins and are billed quarterly.
- C. All new members are obligated to participate in The Building Fund.
- D. All members are billed annually in the 1st Quarter for the Rabbi Emeritus Pension Fund assessment.
- E. Members with children in Aleph-Hey are billed for their Religious School tuition balance in the 4th Quarter

Associate Family Members:

- A. The fiscal membership year is January 1—December 31.
- B. Dues begin in the quarter that the member joins and are billed quarterly.
- C. Associate Members are not required to participate in the building fund program until their oldest child reaches 3rd Grade (Aleph Class) however, they must participate at the, then, current rate.
- D. All members are billed annually in the 1st Quarter for the Rabbi Emeritus Pension Fund assessment.

JCC Kehillah / PBJC Members:

- A. Dues are payable in full when joining PBJC. The fiscal membership year is January 1—December 31
- B. Dues after the first year will be billed in full in the first quarter of each fiscal year according to the Membership category.
- C. There is no Building Fund commitment during the one-year JCC Kehillah.

The Building Fund:

All new family and individual members are obligated to participate in the PBJC Building Fund starting when they join. Associate Family Members are also obligated to pay into the Building Fund, but will not be required to begin making payments until their oldest child reaches 3rd Grade (Aleph Class). The Building Fund is billed quarterly over a period of 6 years or until the obligation is completed, whichever comes first. The Building Fund amount will be fixed at the time that the obligation is made and will not be increased. Members who have paid into a building fund at another Synagogue are eligible to receive full credit for the amount paid. A letter from the Synagogue stating the amount paid into their building fund is required in order to receive a credit toward the PBJC Building Fund. This letter should be forwarded to the PBJC Executive Director for proper accounting.
