MEMBERSHIP TYPES:

Two Adults in household: \$2,375.00*

One Adult in household: \$2,080.00*

Senior Couple (at least one member age 65+): \$1,758.00*

Senior Individual (age 65+) \$1,157.00

Senior Plus Couples (at least one member over age 80): \$923.00

Senior Plus Individual (over age 80): \$ 634.00

Associate Member (no residence within 100 miles of synagogue): \$250.00 (does not include HH Tickets)

Building Fund:

\$3,000 payable over 6 years, billed quarterly

Note— Membership dues (for all members) and Building Fund commitments (for new members) are subject to change as part of the annual PBJC budget process. Members are subject to participating in assessments as approved by the PBJC Board of Trustees.

Special Payment Terms — PBJC offers special payment terms to any member in need. Requests for special terms should be directed to the President. All requests will be kept confidential.

Member Benefit Information

- A. Tickets to the High Holiday Services (as per the PBJC High Holiday ticket policy)
- B. Member discounts for PBJC Nursery School and other programs, when offered.
- C. Early registration privileges for Nursery School, Summer Camp and PBJC early educational programs.

PAYMENT & BILLING INFORMATION

Family and Individual Members:

- A. The fiscal membership year is July 1– June 30.
- B. Dues begin in the quarter that the member joins.
- C. All new members are obligated to participate in The Building Fund.

The Building Fund:

All new family and new individual members are obligated to participate in the PBJC building fund starting when they join. The Building Fund is billed quarterly over a period of 6 years or until the obligation is completed, whichever is first. The Building Fund fee will be set at the time that the obligation is made. Members that have paid into a building fund at another Synagogue or Temple are eligible to receive full credit for the amount paid. A letter from the Synagogue stating the amount paid into the building fund is needed in order to achieve a credit toward the PBJC Building Fund. This letter should be forwarded to the PBJC financial secretary for proper accounting.
